Rev. Bill Byrnes



Fr. Byrnes is a native of Washington, DC and is the youngest of the eight children of Dr. and Mrs. William Byrnes. He attended Georgetown Preparatory School and the College of the Holy Cross. Fr. Byrnes taught at Mater Dei School for three years before being accepted to study as a seminarian for the Archdiocese of Washington. He studied at the Pontifical North American College in Rome, receiving his S.T.B. and S.T.L in Dogmatics from the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas (The Angelicum). He was ordained a priest by Cardinal James Hickey in 1994.

After his ordination Fr. Byrnes served as parochial vicar at the Church of the Little Flower and at the Shrine of St. Jude. For eight years he served as the chaplain to the University of Maryland. From his time serving the Catholic Terps, the Archdiocese of Washington gained fourteen seminarians, and other students pursued vocations with several religious communities. In 2007 Fr. Byrnes delivered the homily for 20,000 young people at the annual Youth Rally and Mass for Life. He currently serves as Pastor of St. Peter's Church on Capitol Hill and as Secretary for Pastoral Ministry and Social Concerns for the Archdiocese of Washington. He also teaches homiletics to the seminarians of the North American College and has spoken at priest convocations, seminarian retreats, and pastoral staff retreats for many dioceses.
