# NATIONAL PRAYER VIGIL FOR LIFE, JANUARY 24-25, 2013

The National Prayer Vigil for Life will be held from Thursday afternoon, January 24, through Friday morning, January 25, 2013. The <u>schedule</u> includes the Opening Mass on Thursday, January 24, at 6:30 pm followed by the National Rosary for Life at 10 pm in the Crypt Church. Evening Prayer (Byzantine Rite) begins at 11 pm. Holy Hours begin at midnight and conclude at 6:00 am on Friday, January 25 with Morning Prayer and Benediction. The Closing Mass begins Monday at 7:30 am. A detailed schedule is <u>here</u>.

#### **Opening Mass Seating**

Please note that there is no reserved seating. Additional seating is provided in the Lower Level Memorial Hall during the Opening Mass. Television monitors and communion distribution will allow those seated in this area to fully participate in Mass.

### Concelebrants, Deacons and Seminarians

Bishops and priests are invited to concelebrate the Opening Mass on January 24 and the Closing Mass on January 25. Deacons are invited to vest and process. Seminarians are welcome to participate in the processional of the Opening Mass; however, they will not recess out after the closing prayer. Seminaries are encouraged to lead an hour of the Holy Hours for Life, held in the Crypt Church from midnight to 6 am. #### Bus Parking & Drop-Off Times

Bus parking permits are no longer available for the Basilica parking lot. Open parking will be available on Harewood Road during the 2013 National Prayer Vigil for Life and related events.

Please note that the new policy for 2012 will be continued into 2013! Buses may begin dropping pilgrims off for the 7:30 am Closing Mass at the Basilica at 5:30 am. Only pilgrims heading to the Crypt Church for Holy Hours will be allowed into the Basilica before this time.
